### 1. Our Enemy at Work

# Later times – Generally accepted as the time between the first and second coming of Christ.

And Jesus answered them, "See that no one leads you astray. For many will come in my name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and they will lead many astray.

Matthew 24:4-5 ESV

I know that after my departure fierce wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock; and from among your own selves will arise men speaking twisted things, to draw away the disciples after them.

Acts 20:29-30 ESV

Depart: Apostacy – moving away from an original position.

# Deceitful spirits: by definition deceit is deliberate.

### ...insincerity of liars whose consciences are seared...

1 Timothy 4:2 ESV

Liars – speakers of falsehood

Seared: branded, burned resulting in becoming unfeeling, unresponsive, or callous.

It is one of the arrogant failures of modernity and even postmodernity to think that all teaching and ideas are only human, and thus ignore even the possibility that ideas may be given by deceitful spirits and teaching of demons. Even New Age spiritualists, who acknowledge the existence of the spiritual realm, have a tendency to assume that all teaching from spiritual sources is good and true and profitable.

#### 2. Distortions we Embrace

...who forbid marriage and require abstinence from foods that God created to be received with thanksgiving by those who believe and know the truth.

1 Timothy 4:3 ESV

Asceticism: Askesis- 'exercise, training, practice.' Renouncing worldly pleasures that distract from spiritual growth & enlightenment & live a life of abstinence & extreme self-denial.

Stoicism: all physical matter is evil. Holiness is in the spiritual realm only.

#### 3. God's Gifts

For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with thanksgiving, for it is made holy by the word of God and prayer.

1 Timothy 4:4-5 ESV

#### 1. Be a Student of the Word

Now these Jews were more noble than those in Thessalonica; they received the word with all eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see if these things were so.


### 2. Embrace the Flawed Community of Christ
